
1. To choose which you'd prefer to use, click on "My Preferences" in the top right corner.




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Some Search Strategies for Learn 360

A. Keyword – searches for the word(s) anywhere in the title, description, subject headings, etc.




Narrow your search using the links down the left side of the page



B. Clicking on “Advanced Search” allows you to choose several search parameters at once, including copyright year, series, and accessibility features.



C. Browsing Standards allows you to drill down into Oregon State Standards, CCSS, or 21st Century Standards and find materials that meet each of the standards.



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Playing and saving media in Learn 360

Streaming = accessing the material in real time over the internet from the Learn360 site


Downloading = storing the material on your computer

We highly suggest downloading materials that you want to use in instruction. Streaming takes up a lot of bandwidth and has the capability to slow down and even crash a system. Downloading ensures it will be available when you need it, without freezing, buffering, etc.

- A. When you click on a title, it will begin to stream immediately. Click the pause button to pause the stream then click the “Download” button below the video.



- B. You can also save a video to your favorites and to a playlist. All content saved this way is accessible by clicking the “My Learn360” button at the top right of the screen.



Note: The first time you try to access “My Learn360”, you’ll have to provide grade level and subject area preferences before it will allow you to see your favorites and playlists.

- C. Copy the link to the video. When pasted into a browser’s address bar, it will allow you (or anyone else with a Learn360 account) to directly access the video. If you’re not currently logged in when pasting the link, you’ll be asked to login.



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
