- **HTML/FTP** refers to a more manual process where individual HTML files (webpages) are edited using either a WYSIWYG or plain text editor, then uploaded via FTP (file transfer) to the web server. This doesn't preclude the use of scripting languages like PHP to provide some convenience (e.g. file includes).
- **CMS** or "content management system" is an application (usually web-based and providing WYSIWYG editing) that allows publishing, editing and modifying content, organizing, deleting as well as maintenance from a central interface. CMSs can be **open source** (i.e. free and open to modification or customization) like WordPress or **proprietary** like EdLine or SchoolWires.
- **"Open source" designs** refer to readily available WordPress themes that have undergone little to no modification (i.e. are "off the shelf"). In the table, individual(s) are credited where themes have been custom made or significantly modified.
