- Aaron Moorelock presentation of in-house inventory system he built
 - “Asset Management System.” In production at South Lane. All fields are searchable. Has interfaces, software and license info, asset tag, name, type, audit dates, updated dates, building, room #/location, make, model, s/n, etc. Can pull up log of activity for devices, including deletions. Can search by PO number to find groups of equipment purchased together. Has device groups option, was designed for tracking COWs and all of their equipment, and can search by groups. Has templates available that can be altered on demand. Fields are added in preferences, and you select whether to display them. Can sort by each column displayed. Can add device types available very easily in config. Software config hasn’t been used yet, working on a plan to implement that. Add quantities to software by adding entitlements. Mobile version for using with iPads. Has a bar code reader function. Fairly easy to add existing information or devices, but no agent that goes out to grab devices on the network. Has an “on loan” field for checking out items, with fields for names and return by dates. Authentication with LDAP. Doesn’t store passwords. Constraints on what types of data can be entered. Working on dynamic reporting, graphs, permissions (view, edit, teacher access, etc). Was a learning curve building this system (learning PERL for example); spent a lot of time researching. This is an open-source project for K-12, if you are interested in this, let Jesse know. If you do use it, and you notice things that need change, let Jesse and Aaron know.
